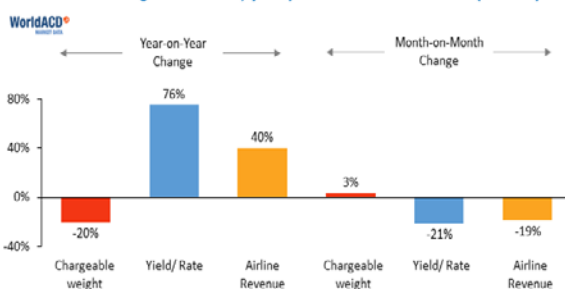


Global & Korea Air Cargo Trends

WorldACD Air Cargo Data for Jun 2020

There have been major changes in the air cargo market since the start of COVID-19, and a huge change that we have never seen before has occurred in the past four months.

June 2020: Change in volume, yield/rate & airline revenue (in USD)

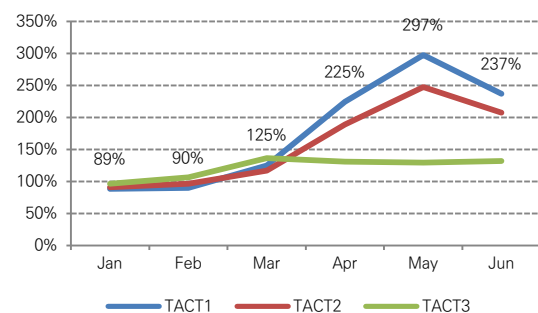


Looking at developments from May to Jun, we saw worldwide volumes increase with almost 3.5%. Coupled with a decrease in USD-yields of 21%, this resulted in a revenue decrease for airlines of 19% measured in USD. In other words, the extreme results of Apr and May (great volume loss coupled with a large revenue increase) diminished somewhat. However, the sector is still far from what it used to be, as Jun worldwide showed a YoY volume decrease of 20% and a yield increase of 76%. [WorldACD]

However, while major airlines around the world are announcing their worst performance, KE announced a surprise turnaround in 2Q due to the performance of the cargo division.

According to the CASS statistics ex KR, the rate of change in airfare compared to the previous year has risen sharply since March in other regions except TACT 3, and peaked in May, but management of receivables due to high fare has become a major issue. Despite of declining since Jun, the price is still higher than the previous year.

- ✓ Golf Accessory: Prohibition of transportation of products containing lithium batteries such as voice caddy and laser range finder.
- ✓ Household Goods : Do not transport various small household appliances (wireless cleaners, rice cookers, speakers, earphones, smart watches, etc.) Products containing lithium batteries, silicone, cleaning agents, hand sanitizers, etc.
- ✓ Frozen vegetables, fruits, etc : If dry ice is included in frozen products, transportation is prohibited.
- ✓ Preparing MSDS for transportation of liquids and powders

2. Precautions
 - ✓ When bringing in cargo, it may be rejected for errors in the export report.
 - ✓ When filing AWB, it is rejected for errors in the export report.
3. Cargo without export declaration
 - ✓ Exclusions : Invoice, Simple export customs clearance list, Mail, A.T.A Carnet re-export, Different in export contract, Sea&Air, Transfer cargo, Other unavoidable cases
 - ✓ Select the cargo type on the KTNET simple input screen, enter it and send it.
