

Global and Korean Air Cargo Trends

Global air cargo demand on the up but with regional variances

Air cargo demand continues to track in line with 2019 levels but regional performance is mixed, according to WorldACD.



The data provider's latest numbers show that air cargo demand in chargeable weight was in May around 1% below 2019 levels — used for comparison given Covid's impact in 2020 — and over the course of the first five months is roughly in line with two years ago. But while volumes were in May up on 2019 levels in Asia Pacific (8%), central and south America (5%) and North America (3%), they

were down in Europe (-8%), Middle East and South Asia (-20%) and Africa (-7%).

Rates meanwhile continued to surge compared with two years ago in all regions — although to varying degrees — due to lost capacity and were up by 77% overall. [Source : WorldACD]

Status of CASS air cargo tonnage ex Korea in May

Demand for air cargo ex Korea showed a relatively similar decline last month compared to last year. As capacity supply fell below market expectations, air freight rates rose for 2 months in a row so many small and medium-sized shippers are complaining about difficulties in logistics and price hikes.

In May, Korea exported the most air cargo by CASS country to China, followed by

A mysterious dictionary useful to know for import T/S cargo

Glossary of terms

What is transit shipment?

- Cargo that needs to be transferred to another aircraft/vessel from a stopover other than the destination.
- It means cargo that is not brought into Korea. (Only available for moving to a bonded warehouse)

T/S cargo terms

• Transmission as T/S cargo when sending the manifest from the origin station.

 The HAWB Consignee address must be overseas. (a third country other than Korea)

Cargo classificati on correction

In case of Import \Rightarrow Transit

- If the HAWB CNEE is overseas, the MAWB CNEE at the stopover will report the manifestation correction.
- In case of Transit \Rightarrow Import
- After MAWB CNEE reports the manifestation correction, post submission of AWB, PL, CI, correction reason, manifestation amendment application and confirmation of approval.

• Status of fuel & other surcharges by carrier

- KE/OZ : FSC to be imposed from 16Jul'21 [long haul : KRW300/Kg, medium range : KRW280/kg, short haul : KRW270/kg]
- LH: Lufthansa cargo increases airfreight surcharge to KRW1,300/kg effective 12Jul'21.

• Other airline & forwarder's information

- **CX**: The cargo division of Cathay Pacific Airways (CX) recently introduced the 'Ultra Track', a cargo location tracking system in earnest. The application of this system will be expanded to 29 airports around the world. By adopting the Bluetooth-based technology developed by Descartes, it will provide real-time visibility. It is also the first Internet of Things (IoT)-based technology introduced by the airline.



 D7 : Malaysia's AirAsia (D7) is boldly strengthening its cargo business. Recently, it introduced the 'B737-800F' cargo plane for the first time. Separately, two new A320s with passenger seats removed were also introduced. This modification improved the cargo loading capacity by about 30%. As a result, the airline's 'A320' modified freighter has increased to a total of eight. The overall cargo operation is carried out through its subsidiary 'Teleport'. [CargoNews]

- Smart cargo terminal construction in ICN : A

future-oriented air cargo infrastructure will be built in the cargo terminal of Incheon International Airport, such as intelligent and automated processes using new technologies of the 4th industry such as unmanned robots, artificial intelligence (AI), and big data. In order to introduce the process and build a test bed, we signed a business agreement with two major national airlines on the 29th to build a future smart cargo terminal. Based on this agreement, KAC and the two major national airlines operating cargo terminals and smart air logistics operation model and test bed Strengthen collaboration, such as building The plan is to develop the world's first smart cargo terminal operating model to which 4th industrial technologies such as unmanned robots, artificial intelligence (AI), and big data are applied around 2024.
