Global and Korean Air Cargo Trends

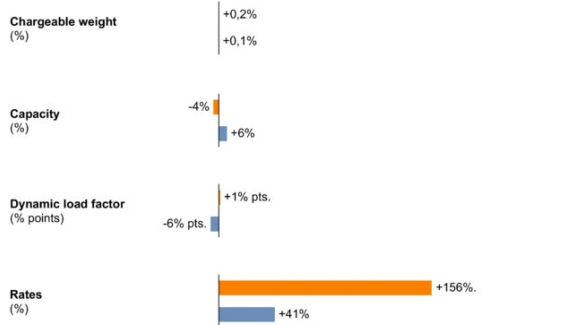
▣ Marginal air cargo volume increase in Jan

General air cargo volumes in January 2022 recorded a 0.1% increase in chargeable weight compared to January 2021, according to the latest industry analysis by CLIVE Data Services.

While the "global airfreight supply chain remains fragile," volumes were also on a par with the pre-pandemic January 2019 level at plus 0.2%, said CLIVE.

Cargo capacity in January 2022, compared to the first month of 2019, was down 4%, and up 6% versus January 2021.

January 2022 global air cargo volumes, capacity load factor and rates developments (Weeks 1-4 of 2022 compared to same weeks in 2021 and 2019)



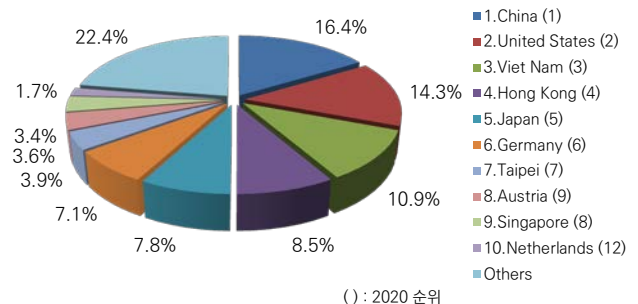

Airfreight rates remained high, compared to the pre-Covid level, at +156% in January 2022 versus January 2019, although this was the

first time in six months that the gap with pre-pandemic rates declined month-over-month, following December's +168% rise. Compared to January 2021, air cargo rates last month were +41%. Measured against all these factors, January's performance shows there is still a good degree of resilience in the global air cargo market. [Source : Aircargo News]

▣ Korea's Export Air Freight Status

According to CASS statistics, in 2021, the largest air export volume by country was to China, followed by the United States, Vietnam, and Hong Kong. The total cargo volume of the Top 10 countries accounted for 77.6% of the total. [Source : CASS]

● EUROPEAN MARKET TRENDS – FEB

- ① International oil prices, which have been on a downward trend for a while, are on the rise due to increased tensions over the Russian invasion of Ukraine, and sea and air freight rates are expected to rise accordingly.
- ② Occasionally, local operations are delayed without prior notice due to the influence of Omicron in Europe. Germany has more than 200,000 confirmed cases per day. Last week, KE FRA cargo operation took about 50 hours or more.

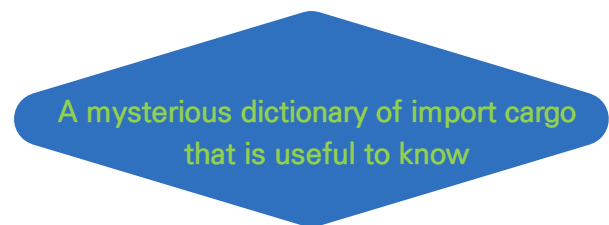

GLOBAL BUSINESS (FAQ about import cargo)



● **Q. Application period for correction of cargo manifest?**

- ① Within 15 days from the date of submission of the report in the case of the unloaded cargo report and irregularity cargo report have been submitted.
- ② If you want to amend the cargo manifest for other reasons, you must do so within 60 days from the date of arrival of the aircraft.

● **Q. List of Imposition of Penalties for Correction of Cargo Manifest**

- ① Added to the cargo manifest of import/export cargo due to omission of B/L and AWB.
- ② Obvious errors in product name (numbers, alphabets, Korean characters, special characters, typos that cannot be inferred from the product name, abbreviations, trademarks, etc.)
- ③ Weight difference of more than 5%
- ④ Changed the name of the importer

- **KE/OZ/Etc** : FSC to be imposed from 16Feb'22

● Other airline & forwarder's information

- **CI/QR** : Due to the booming air cargo market, airlines are placing orders for new freighters one after another. Taiwan China Airlines (CI) recently placed an order for four 'B777F' freighters from Boeing. The total order price is 1.4 billion dollars. The delivery period is from 2023 to 2024. The airline has already placed an order for six 'B777Fs'. Three of them have already been delivered and are in operation, and two of the other three will be delivered this year and the other one early next year. Qatar Airways (QR) also ordered 50 'B777-8F' freighters from Boeing. It is the first airline to order this freighter. Out of 50 units, 34 units are confirmed and 16 units are optional [CargoNews]
- **KE** : Lithium Battery Instructions, 2022

- **SPK** : The backlog of cargo terminal operated by Swiss Port Korea (SPK) for the foreign airline has finally come to the fore. This is because the prolonged cargo backlog and lack of appropriate countermeasures are acting as a serious problem in air logistics. On the 18th of last month, the Incheon

Airport Forwarding Directors' Council (Chairman: Park Seung-cheol) and Swiss Port Korea, operating airlines (Lufthansa Cargo, Cathay Pacific Air, etc.)) did not find a clear solution at the meeting. On this day, an SPK official explained, "The current capacity of 250 tons on weekdays and about 350 tons on weekends are being brought in, resulting in delays in getting off, etc. As a solution, he said that he would discuss the transfer of KJ cargo volume to CSRT. [CargoNews]

- **NH** : Nippon Airways (NH) recently announced that it will operate 14 cargo routes centered on Narita (NRT), including temporary flights, through this year's cargo business plan. In addition to ORD, the 'B777F' freighter will be installed for routes to LAX, FRA, and PVG. On the Shanghai route, one of the four weekly flights operates 'B777F' and the other three operate 'B767F'. In addition, two weekly flights to Frankfurt are operated in the form of temporary freighters that are flexible according to demand. In addition, ICN, BKK, SIN, HKG, TPE, and PEK, DLC, TAO, XMN, and CAN 10 routes will install B767F freighters. [CargoNews]
