

Global and Korean Air Cargo Market Trends

First signs of recovery in air cargo?

The air cargo market could be showing the first signs of a possible recovery fuelled by the restart of production at Chinese factories. Data provider TAC Index said that while air cargo rates "continued to edge slightly lower" last week there were indications of the "first shoots of recovery" for some time after recent "steep price falls".




The company said that while the overall Baltic Air Freight Index last week fell 0.9% compared with a week earlier, prices out of Hong Kong increased by 2.6%. "After steep falls recently at the lower quintiles of prices being paid, sources say both spot rates and volumes appear to be on the up as production slowly ramps up again in China," the data provider said. Forwarder Flexport said that market demand out of North China is low but there was an upward trend going into last weekend and rates have increased compared to the week prior. However, the company said that demand from most other Asian origins was low. Meanwhile, rates on key trade lanes for the month of February as a whole continued to decline, although they remain above pre–Covid levels. Figures from the Baltic Exchange

Airfreight Index (BAI) show that average rates – both contract and spot – paid by forwarders on services from Hong Kong to North America in February declined to \$4.93 per kg from \$6.14 per kg a month earlier and \$9.68 per kg a year ago. However, they remain above the \$3.54 per kg being paid in February 2019. On services from Hong Kong to Europe the average price being paid by forwarders on flights from Hong Kong to Europe fell to \$4.40 per kg from \$4.96 per kg in January and \$5.80 per kg a year earlier. In February 2019 the average price being paid on the trade stood at \$2.52 per kg. [Air Cargo News]

According to the CASS statistics, in Jan, the total air export volume of each country in Korea was the highest to the United States, followed by China, Vietnam, and Japan, and the rankings show little change compared to the 2022 rankings. The total volume of the top 10 countries accounted for 73.0% of the total. [CASS]

Main issues related to EU ICS2 (Import Control System2)

1. Overview and Procedure

✓ Overview of EU ICS2

For all shipments to/via EU and postal items departing from third countries, the EU through Pre-Loading Advance Cargo Information (PLACI) and Cargo Manifest Report (Pre-Arrival) prior to aircraft arrival. A system for prescreening by customs authorities for the purpose of cargo safety/security

- ✓ Target Cargo: Cargo and postal items to/from EU (including Switzerland, Norway and Northern Ireland)
- ✓ Transmission info : It is mandatory to pre-transmit FWB/FHL Data

Contact information including SHIPPER, CONSIGNEE FULL NAME and E-MAIL Required information Number of cargoes, total weight of cargoes, item information (no broad terms), AWB number (Master/House) – HS-Code for each cargo item (6 Digit- up to 9 allowed), requires bill splitting when adding

Consignee Economic Operators Registration and Identification number (EORI) number (additional information)

- * EORI: A kind of customer code and customs registration number assigned to exporters and importers by customs offices in each EU member state (commonly used in all EU member states)
- ✓ Transmission to : EU customs
- ✓ Transmission time: pre-transmission to the system when the AWB application deadline (loading approval required before loading the cargo)
- ✓ Transmission method: Transmission of MAWB/HAWB information and additional information received from the customer in the form of FWB/FHL through the airline system
- ✓ Implementation date: 2023.3.1

Please be sure to check the above information and pay attention to your work to avoid disadvantages in customs clearance.
